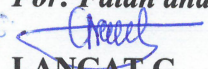

RE: DEMAND FOR REFUND OF KSHS 2,900,000/= RECEIVED FROM MR. ERIC MUNENE IN RELATION TO ONNIX INTERNATIONAL LIMITED VS PINTO KIDIGE OMONGE & SYLVIA MATANKOLE OKODE-PROPERTY KNOWN AS TOWN HOUSE NO 1 TITLE NO. KAJIADO/KAPUTIEI NORTH/113994.

We act for and on behalf of **Mr. Eric Munene** (hereinafter “**our Client**”) on whose instructions we address you as follows.

Our Client informs us that you entered into discussions with him wherein you represented that you would assist him in the recovery of monies lost to one **Mr. Pinto Kidige Omonge**, amounting to over Kenya Shillings Eleven Million (Kshs. 11,000,000/=).

Further, you expressly undertook and/or represented to our Client that you would facilitate and aid in the recovery process through the intended auction and realization of the property known as **Town House No. 1 Title No. KAJIADO/KAPUTIEI NORTH/113994**, belonging to the said Mr. Pinto.

Arising from your representations, assurances and undertakings, our Client proceeded to remit to you various sums of money on diverse dates totaling Kenya Shillings Two Million Nine Hundred Thousand (Kshs. 2,900,000/=) particularized as follows:

The said monies were paid to you on the clear understanding that they were to facilitate and/or aid the intended recovery process and auction proceedings concerning the aforesaid property.

However, despite receiving the said funds, you have failed and/or neglected to undertake the agreed process or refund the monies to our Client, thereby turning the entire transaction into a scheme aimed at unlawfully obtaining money by false pretences, occasioning our Client substantial financial loss and exposing you to both civil and criminal liability under the laws of Kenya.

TAKE NOTICE therefore that we hereby demand the immediate and unconditional refund of the sum of Kenya Shillings Two Million nine Hundred Thousand (Kshs. 2,900,000/=) within **FORTY-EIGHT (48) HOURS** from the time of receipt of this letter.

Should you fail, refuse and/or neglect to comply with this demand within the stipulated period, we have firm instructions to immediately institute both civil and criminal proceedings against you without further reference to you.

Kindly treat this matter with the urgency and seriousness it deserves.

RE: RESPONSE TO YOUR DEMAND FOR KES. 2,900,000/=
YOUR CLIENT: ERIC MUNENE

The above matter and your letter of 14th May, 2026 refer.

We are in receipt of your above-mentioned letter whose contents we have noted and wish to respond thereto as hereunder;

That your letter is grossly misguided and contains a clear misunderstanding of the nature of the engagement between ourselves, your **MR. LANGAT** of **0713 077 208** and your said client. We now wish to clarify the circumstances leading to your demand letter as hereunder;

1. That on or about 17th day of September, 2025, your client approached the undersigned stating that he had lost a sum of **KES. 11,000,000/=** to a one **PINTO KIDIGIE** whom he had learnt in confidence was our client on a matter involving **TOWNHOUSE NO. 1 KAJIADO/KAPUTIEI NORTH/11394**.
2. That we informed your client that we were unable to assist him with the recovery of the said sum or location of whereabouts of **PINTO KIDIGIE MATANKOLE** (Hereinafter "**Our Client**") but that we had instructions on behalf of our said client over purchase of the above-mentioned property which still had a pending balance that was accruing interest.
3. That we held various meetings with your client in your presence where we agreed that your client would advance the sum of **KES. 5,362,537/=** towards clearing the outstanding balance of purchase price as well as interests to facilitate transfer of the property to our client.
4. By so doing, it would be possible for you to carry out execution proceedings for recovery of your client's **KES. 11,000,000/=** by taking out legal proceedings and consequently attaching the same in execution for the resultant decretal sum.
5. Whereas the said sums were to be remitted by 4th December, 2025, your client failed to remit the same in time and only advanced the undersigned the sum of **KES. 2,900,000/=** as follows;

6. As you may be able to see by yourselves, this amount fell short of the initially requested advancement of KES. 5,362,537/= and as such frustrated the arrangement hereinabove described, thereby forcing us to find our own means of completing the payment to save the property.
7. As you may also be able to tell, the said sums were advanced to the undersigned over a period of four (4) months and in payments of bit by bit.

The purpose of this letter is therefore to address you as hereunder;

1. **THAT** the undersigned did not and has never promised to recover KES. 11,000,000/= paid to PINTO KIDIGIE MATANKOLE in their own arrangements, but instead guaranteed to secure the property of the said client to enable you to carry out execution proceedings.
2. **THAT** the undersigned acknowledges receipt of the sum of KES. 2,900,000/= as an advancement from your client and accepts to refund your client in the same manner and fashion of advancement, to wit;
 - a. KES. 1,000,000/= on or before 15th June, 2026
 - b. KES. 1,000,000/= on or before 12th July, 2026
 - c. KES. 200,000/= on or before 17th July, 2026
 - d. KES. 400,000/= on or before 25th August, 2026
 - e. KES. 200,000/= on or before 11th September, 2026
 - f. KES. 100,000/= on or before 20th September, 2026.
3. **THAT** the undersigned **SHALL NOT** pay the sum of KES. 2,900,000/= within the forty-eight (48) hours or any such other timelines that fall short of the time taken by your client to advance him the said funds but shall refund the same as above stated.

We encourage you to consider this proposal as the main intention of the arrangement was to assist your client recover his money. Please also note that we are no longer interested in continuing with the arrangement at all, and instead, shall ensure that your client is refunded his full sums as above clarified.
