EMCA CAP 387 Section 137 provides that ANY PERSON who fails, neglects or refuses to carry out an Order or Requirement issued under this Act by an Environmental Inspector, commits an offence and shall, on conviction be liable to imprisonment for a term of not less than 1 year but not more than four years, or to a fine of not less than two million but not more than four million or to both such fine and imprisonment.
