OPENING OF THE UNIVERSITY

Egerton University Njoro Main Campus and Nakuru Town Campus College will open for normal academic activities as follows:-

1. Faculty of Health Sciences

Reporting - Friday 10th January 2020

End of year examinations - Monday 3rd to Friday 28th February 2020

2. All other faculties

Semester I (2019/2020 Academic Year)

Reporting - Friday 10th January 2020

Examinations - Monday 13th to Friday 24th January 2020

Semester II (2019/2020 Academic Year)

Reporting - Saturday 25th January 2020 Lectures - Monday 27th January 2020

3. All postgraduate students

Reporting - Friday 10th January 2020 Lectures - Monday 13th January 2020

The following reporting conditions shall apply:

- 1. All undergraduate students who were in Njoro Main campus for the 1st semester of the 2019/2020 academic year **MUST** pay a surcharge of **Kes. 16,862** (Kenya shillings Sixteen Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty Two) towards repair, replacement and restoration of damaged property at the University. Students with disability and those from other campuses are exempted from paying the surcharge. The surcharge will automatically be debited to each student's portal.
- The surcharge must be paid to the respective university fee bank accounts or by M-Pesa Paybill Nos. 691021 (Njoro), 691051 (Nakuru Town Campus College), Account Name: (Student Reg. No.) not later than Wednesday 8th January 2020 to enable registration before reporting.
- 3. Students with outstanding fees MUST pay in full and register before reporting back to the university. The registration portal will be open until Wednesday 8th January 2020.
- 4. ONLY fully registered students shall be allowed to sit for end of semester examinations. Printed examination cards MUST be presented to the respective Chair of Department for endorsement on Friday, 10th January 2020.
- 5. Students who will not have completed registration by the opening dates will automatically be deferred.
- Any student who reports and presents him/herself for an examination without clearing fees and paying the surcharge will be subjected to disciplinary process and handed over to the relevant Law enforcement agencies.
