- I, <u>WALUBENGO WANINGILO</u> an Advocate of this Honourable Court and of Post Office Box Number 7917-00100, Nairobi in the Republic of Kenya, do hereby certify that this matter is urgent for the following reasons: -
 - 1. <u>THAT</u> the 1st Applicant is a director of Purma Holdings Limited, the Interested Party herein.
 - 2. <u>THAT</u> the 2nd and 3rd Applicants were former directors of Purma Holdings Limited in their minority age and years.
 - 3. <u>THAT</u> the Kenya Revenue Authority, the 3rd Respondent herein has issued notices to the Applicants herein requiring their joint attendance at its offices for alleged nonpayment of taxes.

- 4. <u>THAT</u> the 1st Applicant who is the current director of Purma Holdings Limited is currently out of the country.
- 5. <u>THAT</u> the 3rd Respondent has been conducting taxation investigations on the Interested Party for the last 2 years. That all along the Interested Party has cooperated and has provided all demanded documents and information and sought clarification whenever necessary. The latest communication being on 17th June 2021.
- 6. <u>THAT</u> the 3rd Respondent has now threatened to initiate proceedings to have all the Applicants arrested and arraigned in court on Criminal charges while the Investigations are not complete as per the Interested Party's Auditors letter to the 3rd Respondent referred to in the immediate preceding paragraph.
- 7. THAT all the Applicants are ready and willing to honour the said notices and summons herein when the 1st Applicant the current director of Purma Holdings Limited comes back into the country and after the 2nd and 3rd Applicants have been appraised on the apparent taxation dispute between the Interested Party and the 3rd Respondent.
- 8. <u>THAT</u> the 2nd and 3rd Applicants are not conversant with the matters the subject of investigations by the 3rd Respondent as their being and removal as directors of the Interested Party herein in the past were the sole actions of the 1st Applicant.
- 9. THAT the 2nd and 3rd Applicants are neither directors, employees, agents nor customers of the Interested Party as to make them be in a position to know and answer to the subject of the summons to them dated 23rd June 2021 by the 3rd Respondent.
- 10. <u>THAT</u> the said summons dated 23rd June 2021 were served vide e-mail to the Applicants late in the day on 24th June 2021 and required the Applicants to appear at 2.00pm on 25th June 2021 and answer to investigations regarding alleged taxation matters worth Kshs.2,535,410,527.00 involving the Interested Party herein.
- 11. <u>THAT</u> the summons, despite the gravity of the subject matter and brevity of notice, contained pointed threat that failure to appear would result in unspecified legal action against the Applicants by the 3rd Respondent.
- 12. <u>THAT</u> the Applicants appointed the Law firm of Walubengo Waningilo& Co. Advocates to plead for reasonable time for the Applicants :
 - (a) For the 1st Applicant to return to Kenya having been summoned while she was abroad
 - (b) For the 2nd and 3rd Applicants to be appraised and made to understand the subject of investigations before they appear to answer on the same.

- 13. THAT I, Walubengo Waningilo, Advocate, appeared on behalf of the Applicants at the 3rd Respondent's offices on 6th Floor, Ushuru Pension Towers at 2.00pm on 25th June 2021. That I waited till 3.30pm when I met Dominic Keng'ara and a lady Legal Officer of the 3rd Resondent. That I presented to them the predicaments of the Applicants, sought extension of time for the Applicants to appear, supporting the pleas with prove of exit from Kenya and entry into Zambia of the 1st Applicant pre-summons; and CR-12 showing that the 2rd and 3rd Applicants are not directors of the Interested Party. The officers insisted that the Applicants must appear, latest Monday the 28th June2021. Failure to appear will be followed by realization of the threatened legal action, arrest.
- 14. THAT in the circumstances the Applicants are apprehensive that the Respondents are determined to have all of them in custody by all means possible and will abuse their powers in disregard of the Constitution to meet their objectives.
- 15. THAT the rush with which the 3rd Respondent is currently conducting itself is inimical to the constitutional rights of the Applicants, in particular provisions of Article 47 of the Constitution.
- 16. <u>THAT</u> it is thus only fair and just that this Application is heard forthwith and the orders sought granted.

17. Hence the extreme urgency of this application.

- 6. <u>THAT</u> the 3rd Applicant and I ceased being directors of Purma Holdings when on realizing that the two of us had other interests for our respective careers in life, our mother removed us.(*Annexed herewith and marked ENM2 a copy of the Change of Directors*).
- 7. <u>THAT</u> since then 3rd Applicant and myself are neither shareholders, directors, employees agents nor customers of the Interested Party to be in positions of persons of interest capable of answering questions regarding taxation disputes between the Interested Party and the 3rd Respondent.
- 8. <u>THAT</u> on 24th June 2021 the 1st and the 3rd Applicants and myself received notices dated 23rd June 2021 to appear jointly at the 3rd Respondents offices on 25th June 2021 at 2.00PM.(*Annexed herewith and marked ENM3(a) (b) and (c) are copies of the said Notices*)
- 9. <u>THAT</u> the 1st Applicant is currently out of the country away in Zambia on earlier scheduled business engagements. (*Annexed herewith and marked ENM4* is a copy of the 1st applicants travel documents)
- 10. <u>THAT</u> we instructed our Advocates on record to communicate our inability to comply with the summons dated 23rd June 2021 and received late on 24th June 2021 on the following grounds:
 - (a) the absence of the 1st Applicant from the Country
 - (b) the 3rd Applicant's and my own lack of information and understanding of the entire dispute between the 3rd Respondent and the Interested Party
 - (c) the need for some time for the 2 of us to be appraised of the matter so that we could answer from the point of information and understanding of the subject at hand.
- 11. <u>THAT</u> our Advocate has reported to us, and we verily believe and trust his report, that he attended the offices of the 3rd Respondent on the 25th June 2021 at 2.00pm wherein he met the officers that had summoned the Applicants to appear. That the officers of the 3rd Respondent are adamant that the Applicants must appear before them latest 28th June 2021, failing which legal action shall be taken against them.
